

Only When a Party Has Struck Its Roots Deep Among the Broad Masses

One day in August Juche 66 (1977), Chairman **Kim Jong Il** stressed the need to work with the masses efficiently while giving his opinions on some problems arising in the struggle for improving and intensifying the work of the Workers' Party of Korea.

He said: Only when a party has struck its roots deep among the broad masses by properly working with them and win their support, it can fully display its might as a leading force and successfully carry out the revolution and construction.
