

Ryongyon Falls

The Ryongyon Falls is located on the southern slope of Popwang Peak in Mt Myohyang, one of the famous mountains in Korea.

The waterfall is 84 metres high and 105 metres long.

The conspicuous slanting waterfall ranks among the falls in Mt Myohyang for its magnificent and scenic beauty.

Over the falls is a pond, which is 3m in diameter and 1.5m deep.

The water from the valley of Popwang Peak overflows in this pond, forming the waterfall.

About 50 metres to the left of the waterfall is the Sanju Falls, and the Chonsin Falls above it.

The Inho Rock standing beside it and opposite the Sangwon Rock commands a bird's-eye view of the three waterfalls.

The scenery of the three waterfalls seen not from afar can be enjoyed only in this mountain. The Korean ancestors called this scenery as one of eight scenic beauties of Mt Myohyang.
