Wau Island

It is located in Nampho, South Phyongan Province.

Known as a scenic spot in the western coast from olden times, it is named so because it looks like a lying ox.

Several hillocks including Wau Hill covered with various trees, cliffs, sandy beach and pine forest go well with the scenery of the Taedong River and the West Sea of Korea.

Most spectacular are the flower blossoms in spring, green verdure in summer and red tints and ripened fruits in autumn.

Found here are a pavilion on Wau Hill, bathing resort, boating ground, volleyball and basketball courts, table tennis hall and other sports facilities and public welfare facilities.
