## Mt. Jangsu

Situated in the area bordering Jaeryong and Sinwon counties, South Hwanghae Province, Mt. Jangsu stands 745m above sea level and stretches about 12km from the east to the west and approximately 5km from the north to the south.

For its exquisite beauty it is called *Kumgang of Hwanghae Province*, a famous mountain of Korea.

Its highest peak is Pojok.

In olden times it was also called Mt. Chiak in the sense that it abounds with pheasants.

The centerpiece of its beauty is the scenes that its valleys offer.

The Korean ancestors, struck with admiration for its valley scenery, said: "Whereas Mt. Kumgang is the prince of mountain beauty in the mountainous area in the eastern region, Mt. Jangsu can be called the queen of valley beauty in the western plain region."
